

KeyHIE Leads the Way in COVID-19 Response

We find ourselves in unprecedented times with the battle against the novel coronavirus known as COVID-19. KeyHIE is playing a vital role in combating the spread of the virus. We currently host a dashboard displaying information related to COVID-19 progression and diagnosis to serve as a real-time decision making tool. This information is displayed concurrently with the PA Department of Health map to assist Geisinger leadership with resource allocation and planning.

Along with other PA HIEs, KeyHIE is also partnering with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and P3N to offer COVID-19 reporting data to the Governor's Office and the Pennsylvania Department of Health. The

Commonwealth will be utilizing this data to assist with health care surge planning and modeling as we continue to combat the ongoing pandemic.
